2.5. Personal Data Protection

The French department of Bouches-du-Rhône, as data controller, endeavors to ensure the privacy of the Users on the Website, in accordance with Regulation (EU) n° 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council dated April 27th 2016 known as the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and reviewed French “*Informatique et Libertés*” Law n°78-17 dated January 6th 1978 (hereafter jointly referred to as “**Applicable legislation**”).

Users are hereby informed that personal data communicated through the Website or its services may be processed as follows :

- Handling Users email requests for contact or information

Users may communicate personal data (email address, identification data, request related data) by placing a request for contact or information directly by email. Such information is therefore processed by the French department of Bouches-du-Rhône based on his legitimate interest to handle contact and information requests. In such cases, Users are invited to refrain from communicating sensitive data.

Personal data thus collected is retained only as long as necessary to satisfy the request, and may not be stored after the festival has ended, unless an extension of the duration is necessary regarding the nature of the request as set by applicable storage legislation depending on limitation period.

- Sending email alerts about the festival

Users may also communicate their email address in order to receive email alerts concerning the festival’s detailed program and announcing the booking opening.

Such data is processed by the French department of Bouches-du-Rhône based on his legitimate interest to promote the event, when Users have indicated such



wish by filling in their email address. It is retained only until such alert is sent, then securely suppressed.

- **Press accreditation and area :**

Media professionals may request an accreditation allowing them to access the Press area. In such cases, their personal data will be processed (identity of the requesters, email addresses, proof of their professional ID, user ID, and any information they choose to communicate by mail).

Such data is then processed on the basis of the legitimate interest of the French department of Bouches-du-Rhône, in order to select the beneficiaries of the Press accreditation.

Personal data thus collected may not be stored after the festival has ended, unless an extension of the duration is necessary regarding the nature of the request as set by applicable storage legislation depending on limitation period.

- **Professional accreditation**

As professionals, some Users may request a professional accreditation. In such cases, their personal data shall be collected (name, first name, company, phone number, email address, company address, profession, a short professional biography and a copy of their ID if they are under 30 years old).

Such data is then processed on the basis of the legitimate interest of the French department of Bouches-du-Rhône, in order to select the beneficiaries of the professional accreditation.

Specifically, the ID of under 30 years old professionals is processed in order to grant a reduced price for the accreditation.

Personal data thus collected may not be stored after the festival has ended, unless an extension of the duration is necessary regarding the nature of the request as set by applicable storage legislation depending on limitation period.

- **Professional area**



Personal data collected for the professional accreditation is also used to create an account and an ID for the professional area. The account enables professional Users to make appointments online.

This processing activity is based on the performance of the accreditation selling contract.

Personal data thus collected is retained until Users chose to delete their account and may not be stored after the festival has ended, unless an extension of the duration is necessary regarding the nature of the request as set by applicable storage legislation depending on limitation period.

- **Booking and payments**

Ticket booking and accreditation payment are subcontracted to Weezevent as Personal Data Processor. Legal information related to such processing activities is delivered by Weezevent, in accordance with article 25 of [Weezevent Terms of Use](#).

In all cases information thus collected may be used only by authorised personnel or contractual processors, as far as needed for indicated purposes. Such information is neither communicated to third parties, nor retained any longer than necessary to achieve those purposes, without prejudice to applicable storage obligations.

In any case, the French department of Bouches-du-Rhône implements appropriate technical and organisational measures in order to ensure an adequate level of security for personal data collected and processed on the Website or through associated services.

In accordance with Applicable legislation, Users have a right to ask for their personal data access, rectification, erasure, portability (when applicable), and for restriction and to object to the processing operations.

These rights may be exercised writing to the French department of Bouches-du-Rhône's Data Protection Officer (DPO), via email (dpo13@departement13.fr) or postal mail (Département des Bouches-du-Rhône /A l'attention du Délégué à la



protection des données / Hôtel du Département / 52, avenue de Saint Just / 13256 Marseille Cedex 20). Data subjects also have a right to place a request directly with the CNIL, French data protection authority.

Users acknowledge they are bound to follow GDPR when visiting the Website and using its services, notably by abstaining from collecting and / or unlawfully using persona data thus accessed.
